

**City of Fox Lake
Committee of the Whole Synopsis
January 15, 2020**

The January 15, 2020 committee of the whole meeting was called to order by Mayor Tom Bednarek, at 6:40 p.m., following a special council meeting. Those in attendance were alderpersons John Mund, Dan Ault, Dennis Linke, Peter Hartzheim, Robert Jenswold and Don Zilewicz. Also attending were city attorney Mike Devitt, police chief Jim Rohr, public works superintendent Gene Huettner and municipal clerk Susan Hollnagel. There was no one in the audience.

GO Loop water usage

The Mayor said he had talked with GO Loop Contractors, who install closed loop geothermal installations, about the possibility that they may need to operate a private water well within the city's industrial park. He said this probably won't happen as GO Loop will probably use city water. Jenswold said GO Loop had a concern with using chlorinated water in their installations.

Update on signage for ATV routes

The Mayor said the County has to post ATV route signs on county roads. Hartzheim said on Cordelia Street, coming off of CTH A may need a sign and also Mill Road. Rohr said he thinks the township is in the process of approving ATV routes. Huettner reminded them that ATV/UTV aren't allowed until the signs are up.

Conditional Use permit

The Mayor said the Planning Commission had received a conditional use application from LCJ Properties LLC, who purchased 221 W. State Street, to construct two one-bedroom apartments on the second floor. He said at the next Council meeting there will be a public hearing on the Plan Commission's recommendation to grant the condition use permit.

With no other business to come before the committee of the whole, the meeting was adjourned at 6:43 p.m.
