

Legal Proceedings of the City of Fox Lake
Common Council
February 3, 2021

The regular meeting of the City of Fox Lake Common Council was held on Wednesday, February 3, 2021, at 6:30 p.m., in the community center. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tom Bednarek and followed by the pledge of allegiance. Roll call was taken with alderpersons John Mund, Dan Ault, Dennis Linke, Peter Hartzheim, Robert Jenswold and Don Zilewicz present. Also attending was City Clerk Jenny Quirk.

In the audience was Kathy Jenswold.

The Mayor opened the meeting to public comments on agenda items or other matters. Zilewicz asked for confirmation on the decision for allowing the St. Patrick's parade in March 2021. The Mayor stated the event will be allowed as long as nothing was enforced from the government saying otherwise. No aldermen were opposed.

The clerk certified open meeting laws have been complied with.

Approve minutes:

Motion by Linke, seconded by Hartzheim to approve the minutes of the January 20, 2021 special council meeting, as typewritten. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Payment of bills:

Motion by Mund, seconded by Jenswold to approve paying the bills, as audited, for accounts payable check #41446 through #41539, totaling \$574,904.55 (including ACH withdrawals) and for payroll checks #60072 through #60112, totally \$36,322.38. Vote in favor: Ault, Linke, Hartzheim, Jenswold, Zilewicz, and Mund. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the petition to amend the zoning code to require a three (3) foot setback from the property line for fences:

Motion by Mund, seconded by Jenswold to approve the petition to amend the zoning code to require a three (3) foot setback from the property line for fences. Motion carried with a voice vote.
