

Legal Proceedings of the City of Fox Lake
Common Council
March 20, 2019

A special meeting of the City of Fox Lake Common Council was held on Wednesday, March 20, 2019 at 6:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers. Full time police officer position

Motion by Mund, seconded by Linke to offer the vacant full time police officer position to Duane Olbinski Jr. Vote in favor: Mund, Linke, Hartzheim, Jenswold and Zilewicz. Motion carried.

Waive special assessment fees-Forest Street

Motion by Linke, seconded by Zilewicz to waive special assessment fees for three lots on Forest Street: 211 Forest Street \$4,354.00, 212 Forest Street \$4,223.38 and 312 Forest Street \$4,266.92. The Mayor said these assessments have been on the city's books for 20-25 years. He said a developer is willing to buy the lots and build homes on them. He said if approved, the developer will be digging within a month. Vote in favor: Linke, Hartzheim, Jenswold, Zilewicz and Mund. Motion carried.

With no other business to come before the Council, motion by Linke, seconded by Mund to adjourn and go into committee of the whole. Motion carried with a voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 6:33 p.m.
