

**Legal Proceedings of the City of Fox Lake**  
**Common Council**  
**April 7, 2021**

The regular meeting of the City of Fox Lake Common Council was held on Wednesday, April 7, 2021, at 6:30 p.m., in the community center. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tom Bednarek and followed by the pledge of allegiance. Roll call was taken with alderpersons Dan Ault, Peter Hartzheim, Robert Jenswold, Dennis Linke, John Mund and Don Zilewicz present. Also attending were City Administrator Dean Perlick, Police Chief James Rohr, City Treasurer Krystal McCauley and City Clerk Jenny Quirk.

In the audience were Kathy Jenswold, Wayne Kok and Tom Alsum.

During public comments Hartzheim spoke about the reopening of the outdoor pavilions and concession stand. The council agreed that these could be reopened to renting and use.

Also discussed during public comments was the concerns about the City's garbage pick-up. Zilewicz commented that the garbage pickup is not happening constantly and we as a City need to address it. Perlick noted that there have been multiple attempts being made, but little is being done on the garbage collection companies end. He has emailed a representative at Waste Management, but they did not understand why there were so many problems and they were going to look into the situation. In the meantime, we are documenting complaints and situations.

The Mayor thanked Alderman Jenswold for his many years of dedicated service and commitment to the City.

The clerk certified open meeting laws have been complied with.

**Approve minutes:**

Motion by Mund, seconded by Linke to approve the minutes of the March 3, 2021 council meeting, as typewritten. Motion carried with a voice vote.

**Payment of bills:**

Motion by Mund, seconded by Zilewicz to approve paying the bills, as audited, for accounts payable check #41629 through #41725, totaling \$392,838.96 (including ACH withdrawals) and for payroll checks #60154 through #60195, totally \$35,257.02. Motion carried with a voice vote.

**Presentation by Baker Tilly U.S. LLP:**

Motion by Jenswold, seconded by Mund to approve the brief review of the 2020 financial statement audit as presented by Jodi from Baker Tilly U.S. LLP. Motion carried with a voice vote.

**Discuss the proposal to develop eight single family residential lots along Oaks Road:**

Tom Alsum, from the Fox Lake Golf Course, noted that the first 100 feet off of Oaks Road, owned by the Fox Lake Golf Course, is in the City of Fox Lake. While the remaining land, owned by the Fox Lake Golf

Course, is in the Town of Fox Lake. The Fox Lake Golf Course would like to be able to sell lots along Oaks Road to be developed as single family homes. They are requesting that 100 feet off of Oaks Road either be moved to the Town of Fox Lake or the City of Fox Lake keep it and annex more land including Oaks Road, so the lots will be in the same municipality and large enough to build on. Perlick noted there would be many factors and expenses to consider as well as approval needed from the Board of Zoning Appeals. Additional information is being gathered for further discussion.

**Approve Julio Moscoso for the Utility Technician 1 position:**

Motion by Mund, seconded by Zilewicz to hire Julio Moscoso for the Utility Technician 1 position starting at \$17.00 an hour with a \$1.00 an hour raise after obtaining a CDL and an additional \$1.00 an hour raise after obtaining the necessary water certifications. Vote in favor: Hartzheim, Jenswold, Linke, Mund, Zilewicz and Ault. Motion carried.

**Portable restroom at Clausen Park:**

Motion by Hartzheim, seconded by Zilewicz to approve a rental agreement with Environmental Specialists, for a portable restroom to be located at Clausen Park boat launch area, from May 1, 2021-September 31, 2021. Motion carried with a voice vote.

**Pest Control Services at the Library and Fire Department:**

Motion by Jenswold, seconded by Zilewicz to approve the City paying the \$25.00 a month charge, per building, for pest control services at the Library and Fire Department buildings. Motion carried with a voice vote.

**Bid for Green Street Reconstruction Project:**

Motion to accept the bid from Forest Landscaping & Construction, Inc. Lake Mills, of \$842,270.30 for the Green Street Reconstruction Project. Vote in favor: Jenswold, Linke, Mund, Zilewicz, Ault and Hartzheim. Motion carried.

**Fox Lake Aquatic Center 2021 season pool pass rates:**

Discussion to establish the cost of pool passes at the Fox Lake Aquatic Center for the 2021 season. In consideration of adding an additional week of pool availability it was decided to set the rates as follows: Individual season passes \$40.00, family season passes \$75.00, daily passes 4 years old and older \$5.00, daily passes 3 years old and under free, daily passes 60+ \$3.00 and daily passes after 5:00 pm \$2.00. All council members were in agreement.

With no other business to come before the Council, motion by Mund, seconded by Zilewicz to adjourn. Motion carried with a voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
