

**Legal Proceedings of the City of Fox Lake
Common Council
May 5, 2021**

The regular meeting of the City of Fox Lake Common Council was held on Wednesday, May 5, 2021, at 6:30 p.m., in the community center. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tom Bednarek and followed by the pledge of allegiance. Roll call was taken with alderpersons Dan Ault, Marcy Benz, Peter Hartzheim, Dennis Linke and Don Zilewicz present. John Mund was absent. Also attending were City Administrator Dean Perlick, Police Chief James Rohr and City Clerk Jenny Quirk.

In the audience were Sarah Theander, Lynn Sullivan and Kayla Sharpee.

No public comments were made.

The clerk certified open meeting laws have been complied with.

Approve minutes:

Motion by Linke, seconded by Zilewicz to approve the minutes of the April 21, 2021 organizational council meeting, as typewritten. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Payment of bills:

Motion by Linke, seconded by Hartzheim to approve paying the bills, as audited, for accounts payable check #41726 through #41827, totaling \$239,552.08 (including ACH withdrawals) and for payroll checks #60197 through #60238, totally \$36,130.89. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Vacant City lot on Makenick Street:

Motion by Hartzheim, seconded by Benz to allow Merle and Cheryl Kok to purchase the vacant lot owned by the City at the end of Makenick Street. Vote in favor: Benz and Hartzheim. Vote against: Ault, Linke and Zilewicz. Motion not carried.

Planting of trees for current or past officials/employees:

Motion by Hartzheim, seconded by Zilewicz to approve the planting of a tree in the honor of current and past officials/employees that pass away, to be managed by DPW. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Renting the community center:

Motion by Linke, seconded by Hartzheim to allow accepting of reservations for the rental of the community center. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Friends of Clausen Park fund raiser:

Motion by Benz, seconded by Linke to approve allowing the use of Clausen Park on Saturday, September 4, 2021 and granting of a temporary Class "B" picnic license to sell fermented malt beverages for a Friends of Clausen Park fund raiser, "A Day In The Park Fisheree". Motion carried with a voice vote.

Chicken License:

Motion by Benz, seconded by Zilewicz to approve an application for the keeping or maintaining of chickens for Bonnie Steinmetz located at 309 Mill St Motion carried with a voice vote.

With no other business to come before the Council, motion by Linke, seconded by Ault to adjourn. Motion carried with a voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
