Committee of the Whole Synopsis
June 16, 2021

The June 16, 2021 committee of the whole meeting was called to order by Mayor Tom Bednarek, at 11:08 a.m., following the special council meeting. Those in attendance were Alderpersons Dan Ault, Marcy Benz, Peter Hartzheim, Dennis Linke and John Mund. Don Zilewicz was absent. Also attending were Police Chief James Rohr, Librarian Erin Anders and City Clerk Jenny Quirk.

There was no one in the audience.

Public Works:

The Mayor noted he had spoken with a representative from the state DOT to let us know when the 2500 feet of road work on State St is scheduled to be done.

Library:

Librarian Anders shared that the library will be extending their hours again, beginning next week. Also, the summer reading program starts next week. They are allowing volunteers in to start working upstairs. They also have a community survey they are working on getting out, to see what the community wants from the library. The bushes have been removed around the library building to improve visibility at the intersection and to protect the building from the root growth. There is a boyscout looking for his Eagle Scout project and plans to complete the remainder of the landscaping work.

City Administrator:

The Mayor asked the Council about moving meetings back into the Council Chambers. All were in favor of moving the meetings back into the Council Chambers starting in July 2021.

Building & Parks:

The Mayor shared updates that are happening at Clausen Park with repairs and new pier. There was also information shared with the Council regarding the history of the Clausen Park and Riverside Memorial Park names.
