

**City of Fox Lake**  
**Special Committee of the Whole Synopsis**  
**October 7, 2020**

The October 7, 2020 committee of the whole meeting was called to order at 6:48 pm, following the Common Council meeting, by Mayor Tom Bednarek, in the community center. **Water/Sewer utilities**

Discussion of the dates and hours of operation for the Fox Lake pool in the 2021 season. It was decided to have the pool open from June 5 - August 22, 2021 Monday-Friday 1:00 pm-7:00 pm and Saturday -Sunday 12:00 pm – 7:00 pm.

**Building & Parks**

Discuss improvements to Crocker St. Park and construction of a pavilion. The Mayor had spoken with Bob Dolan prior to the meeting. Dolan had stated that as long as the City addresses the issue of lighting and the closed hours for the park their committee will be content.
